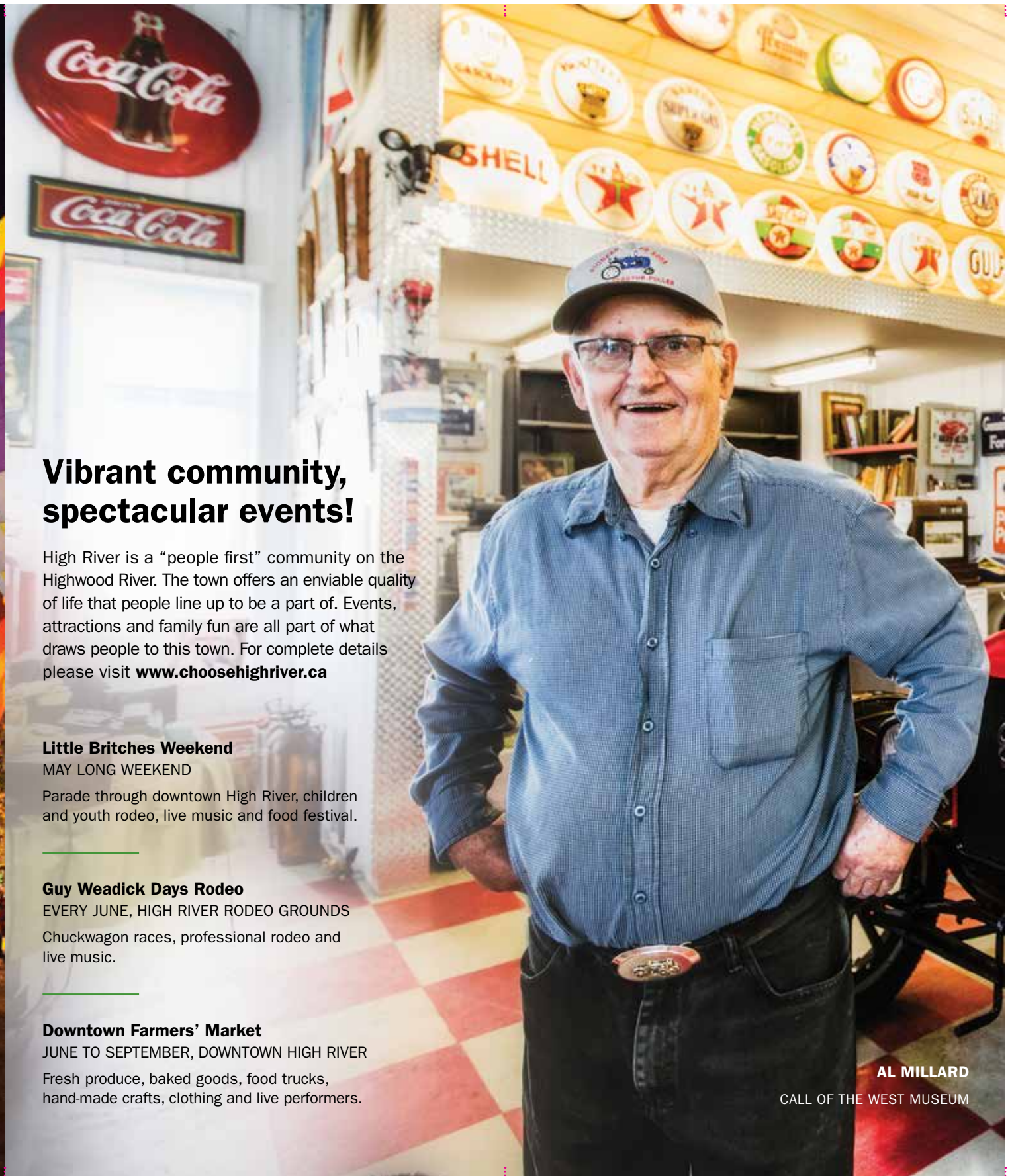
Parade through downtown High River, children and youth rodeo, live music and food festival.
