By-law No. 4131/2005

Being a By-law of the Town of High River in the Province of Alberta to apply a Municipal Historic Resource Designation to the Museum of the Highwood at 406 – 1<sup>st</sup> Street S.W.

WHEREAS Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto, a Council may pass bylaws relating to people, activities and things in, on or near a public place or place that is open to the public and services provided by or on behalf of the municipality in the manner that Council considers appropriate, **and**

WHEREAS Council considers the Museum of the Highwood, which is located on lands in the Town of High River in the Province of Alberta, which are municipally described as 406 – 1<sup>st</sup> Street S. W. which are legally described as:

To be an historic resource as defined in the Historic Resources Act being Chapter H-8, R.S.A. 1980,

WHEREAS Council considers the preservation of such a historic resource to be in the public interest;

NOW  
THEREFORE The Council of the Town of High River in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

That the following described historic resource, being the Museum of the Highwood, being legally described as

Is hereby designated as a Municipal Historic Resource pursuant to Section 22 of the Historical Resources Act.
