BYLAW 4547/2018 –AMENDMENT TO BUSINESS LICENSING BYLAW 4511/2017

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF HIGH RIVER TO AMEND BYLAW 4511/2017 BEING A BYLAW FOR THE PURPOSES OF REGULATING AND LICENSING ALL BUSINESSES CARRIED ON WITHIN THE TOWN OF HIGH RIVER.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 191 of the Municipal Government Act RSA 2000, Chapter M-26, Council may, by Bylaw, amend Bylaws from time to time;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of High River considers it expedient to amend Business Licensing Bylaw 4511/2017, being a bylaw to regulate and license all businesses carried on within the Town of High River;

NOW THEREFORE, the Town of High River Council, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

PART I – PURPOSE, DEFINITIONS, INTERPRETATION AND APPLICATION

Purpose

1. The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend Bylaw 4511/2017, commonly known as the Business Licensing Bylaw.

Short Title

2. This Bylaw may be cited as the “Amendment to Business Licensing Bylaw 4511/2017”.

Definitions

3. Words used in this Bylaw have the same meaning as defined in the *Municipal Government*, with the following changes or additions:
 - (a) “Act” means the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, c. M-26, together with any amendments and Regulations made thereunder;
 - (b) “Bylaw” means Bylaw 4547/2018 also known as the “Amendment to Business Licensing Bylaw 4511/2017” Bylaw;
 - (c) “Council” means the governing body of the Town;
 - (d) “Town” means the municipal corporation of the Town of High River;
 - (e) “Town Manager” means the Town Manager of the Town or his or her delegate.

Interpretation

4. References in this Bylaw to a statute, regulation or other bylaw refer to the current laws at the time this Bylaw was enacted and as they are amended from time to time, including successor legislation.
5. Headings and sub-headings in this Bylaw are included for convenience only, and shall not be considered in interpreting the substantive content of this Bylaw.
6. The preamble paragraphs that precede the numbered paragraphs of this Bylaw are an integral and necessary part of this Bylaw and not a mere recital.
7. Every provision of this Bylaw is independent of all provisions and it is the intention of the Council that if any provision of this Bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all other provisions of this Bylaw shall remain valid and enforceable.

Application

8. Bylaw 4511/2017, commonly referred to as the Business Licensing Bylaw, is hereby amended as follows.

9. That Schedule "A", as attached to this Bylaw 4547/2018, be added to Bylaw 4511/2017.

PART II - GENERAL

Effective Date

10. This Bylaw comes into effect when it is passed by the Council.

Repeals

11. That Schedule "A", Section "FEES RELATED TO THE BUSINESS LICENSING BYLAW", sub-section "VIOLATION TICKET" of Bylaw No 4529/2017, being the penalties section directly related to the Business Licensing Bylaw within Schedule "A" of Rate Bylaw 4529/2017, is hereby repealed.

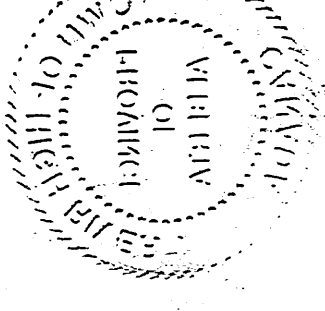
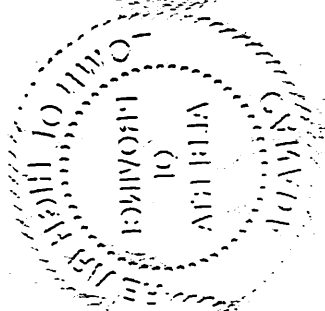
